








Finnish Contribution of Euro-Argo ERIC




CURRENT ACTIVITIES

- Baltic Sea (2011 \rightarrow)
 - development of enhanced monitoring methods
 - data used to validate oceanographic models
 - data assimilated to the operational models
 - process studies.

- Contribute development of shallow water Argos.
